The timeline for the draft has realistically been moves to a year from next town meeting. Gary said he has drafted a mission statement and has found a step by step guide from the Planning Commission of Southern NH. Gary said the focus will be on the last 3<sup>rd</sup> of the plan and not the history or appendices and if they brake up the sections for each person to work on it will be less intimidating.

Mike E had some feedback on Articles 11 & 12 drafts. He discussed ADU's being allowed and ADU rules apply should be added to the article. Long discussion on draft of Article 11 & 12. Discussion main points included what constitutes a class V road and if there should be something written in the article limiting the number of subdivisions by adding a time restriction. Mike B to research Story and Log Cabin Rd. Mike E will add to existing drafts for next meeting. Karen to get timelines again for the Articles to make the ballot for next town election.

There was also a discussion about the widening of the gravel roads in town and how it seems the new grader has some roads almost 40' wide in areas. Should be added to the master plan.
