January 15, 2025

Brenna called the January 15, 2025 meeting of the Nelson Select Board to order at 3:00 PM.

● Police Chief J. Filipi came before the Board with an update on a few pending matters and to report a problem with the muffler on the 2014 cruiser. Filipi reported that he had just returned from the repair shop where he was informed that the muffler is failing and needs to be replaced. He was given an estimate of \$631. With little discussion, Brenna made a motion to approve the repair at a cost of \$631.

Mike seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

Don reminded everyone that a written Purchase Request is needed and asked Filipi to bring one in.

Filipi then reported that he has met with two companies who install cameras and is expecting to meet with one more next week.

Don objects to the proposed cost, as the first estimate is around \$10,000. He would like a "Ring" system investigated or other inexpensive system. Mike reminded that those systems carry a monthly subscription cost in addition to the equipment.

Filipi reported that several Parking complaints have been received from a property owner at Nubanusit Lake. Upon investigating, it was determined that there was no violation but the vehicles have been parking on private land that is not posted for "No Parking". It was suggested that the property owner put "No Parking" signs on their property in the area being used.

● Mike made a motion to approve the minutes for January 8, 2025 as recorded.

Brenna seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● Mike made a motion to approve the Manifest for January 15, 2025 as presented.

Brenna seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● Mike made a motion to approve a Purchase Request from the Fire Department for AED pads. (\$344)

Brenna seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● A request was presented from the Tax Collector to waive the interest for a tax payer who claimed to have dropped his check off in the front drop-box when the office was closed. His check was not found in the box. He issued a new check and indicated he would be requesting a "Stop Payment" on the other. Mike suggested that the Tax Collector present the request again, once there is proof of the "Stop Payment" from the tax payer's bank. All agreed.

● The Board revisited an Intent-to-Cut for R. and E. Hartshorne. As it had been discovered that there was a Conservation Easement on the property, held by the Harris Center, further checking was done before approval. The Harris Center was contacted and they issued a written approval in support of the Intent-to-Cut. Mike then made a motion to approve the intent-to-Cut for R.&E. Hartshorne.

Brenna seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● With nothing further, Mike made a motion to adjourn.

Brenna seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.
