

Town of Nelson Selectmen's Meeting

January 24, 2018

At 3:10 PM David opened the January 24th meeting of the Nelson Select Board.

- Gary made a motion to approve the "NO SLEEPING" sign for the Highway Office. (Per Fire Code requirements)
Maury seconded.
The motion carried 3-0.
- David made a motion to approve the Public and Non-Public minutes for January 10, 2018.
Maury seconded.
The motion carried 3-0
- Maury made a motion to approve the manifest for January 17th and January 24th as presented.
Gary seconded.
The motion carried 3-0.
- The Board reviewed a ZBA appeal of the Selectmen's decision to refer a property owner to the ZBA following a Building Permit request (W. Boger.)
- Mary Cornog came before the Board to present a recommendation from the Share the Roads Committee to purchase multiple small speed monitoring signs rather than a large unit that would be moved with a trailer. After much discussion, it was agreed that more information should be gathered before development of a warrant article for next year.
Mary presented a draft of a brochure that the Share the Roads Committee would like to have printed and made available throughout town. The Committee is seeking funding for the project. They will continue work on the brochure and bring to the Board for review when it is ready for printing.
- Following a discussion of the weather beaten flag over the Town Hall, David made a motion to replace the flag with a flag that could be hung from a wall bracket at the Town Office that could be taken in when the office is closed.

The motion carried 3-0.
- Maury made a motion to accept a Petition Warrant Article to include the "Game of Village" On the 2018 Town Warrant.

- David made a motion to deny budget funding in 2018 for Community Volunteer Transportation Group.

- Following a brief discussion, David made a motion declaring that Old Home Week will be August 5th thru August 11th 2018.

- Maury made a motion to approve a Building Permit for D. Upton for the installation of Solar PV system.
Gary seconded.
The motion carried 2-0. David recused himself from the vote.
- Following a review, Gary made a motion to approve a letter to the Community (with amendments).
Maury seconded.
The motion carried 3-0.
- The Board reviewed concerns from the Library employees regarding their sudden unexplained allergy type symptoms.
The Contractor who installed the insulation and sealing material for the energy conservation project was contacted. He reported no previous problems and advised that the material used is commonly used for spaces that are occupied by individual who are highly allergic.
The Board agreed to order a cleaning of the furnaces and change of all filters as this may be a contributing factor. A small air filtration unit will also be considered.
