

SELECTMEN MEETING

October 12, 2011

Present: Margaret Schillemat, Chair; Warren Hammack, Selectman.

Others Attending: Edith Drinkwater, John Shea, Treasurer; Mike Tarr, Road Agent; Edith Notman, Bud French, Loret Simonds.

All paperwork was signed and read.

- 1) The Department of Labor came to a meeting with Warren Hammack, selectman and Richard Pratt, Police Chief; yesterday, Wednesday 10 12, 2011. They inspected all of the Town buildings and left a list of things that need to be put into place as soon as possible. The town will receive a full report in about 2 weeks.
- 2) Mike Tarr reported on the snowmobile trail bridge etc. The bridge is now 5 feet wide and 12 feet long. It's approximately 5 or 6 years old. It looks like Mr. LeDoux would probably make the class 6 road better. He wants to make the bridge 10 feet wide by 12 feet long. This is to get a groomer across the bridge. This does not appear to be a State approved snowmobile trail. The selectmen would like more clarification on this matter.
- 3) John Shea, Treasurer will be getting all paperwork in order to send to Peterbilt for the purchase of the Town Highway Truck.
- 4) Margaret called for a Executive Session for RSA 91-A 3II (a+c). Warren seconded the motion. Motion passed.
- 5) At 9:00 the executive session closed and the selectmen's meeting resumed. Edith Notman was asked to be on the Safety and Health Committee but she cannot do this right now.
- 6) Loret Simonds – Marlborough, NH came to check on the meetings that were held in Harrisville with the 4 towns. She spoke to the selectmen about what was happening now and who attended the meetings in Harrisville.
