At 3:05 PM Brenna Kucinski opened the December 1, 2021 meeting of the Nelson Select Board.

- Bill made a motion to approve the minutes for November 17, 2021 as recorded.

- Brenna made a motion to approve the manifests for November 24 and December 1, 2021 as presented.

- Bill made a motion to approve a request for 2022 funding from Southwest Community Services in the amount of \$500.

- The State Police (Division of Criminal Records) is offering a new portal for submitting requests for background checks. As Nelson very rarely needs this service, Bill made a motion to decline registering to use the portal and continue to use the printed request whenever needed.

- Bill made a motion to approve the 2020 draft audit and Selectmen's representation letter to the auditors.

- Upon review of a quote and delivery terms, Bill made a motion to approve the purchase of a 40' cargo container for the storage of Emergency supplies and equipment at a cost of \$7,050.

- Brenna reported on a meeting with the Police Chief and a concerned resident regarding roadside parking and use of trails into Partridge Woods that have given rise to privacy concerns for this neighbor. The property owner was urged to post his property and to immediately report any issues of trespass. The parking issues were acknowledged and the resident was informed that efforts are underway to provide additional lot parking to help mitigate this problem.

- Maury made a motion to approve membership to the Nelson Community Power Committee as recommended by the Chair, Patsy Beffa-Negrini: Mary Cornog, Mare-Anne Jarvela, Sandy Mackenzie, Gary Robinson, Lisa Sieverts, Betsy Street, Bill Waterston, and John Zurich as voting members and Non-resident, Rick Weyerhaeuser in an advisory, non-voting, member.
