At 2:30 PM Brenna Kucinski opened the December 15, 2021 meeting of the Nelson Select Board.

● Jason Walter came before the Board to discuss a list of pending issues concerning the Fire Department.

1. Rescue Truck repairs from accident in March of 2020 are still not complete
2. Calls not returned to residents regarding Dry Hydrant planning
3. Resident's complaints regarding lack of response to Burn Permit requests
4. Failure to provide receipts for purchases made with credit card

J. Walter agreed to take immediate action on each outstanding issue

● Maury made a motion to approve the minutes for December 7, 2021 as recorded.

Bill seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● Bill made a motion to approve the manifest for December 15, 2021 as presented.

Maury seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● Due to reporting issues between the water test lab and NH DES the town was required to post notice of late reporting of the November water test. The notice was signed and posted in the Town Hall and the Town Office. Although the sample was taken early and submitted by the lab, NH DES claims not to have received it. NH DES now reports receipt of the lab results showing the system is cleared for drinking.

● Maury made a motion to approve a letter to Bob Madden of the Granite Lake Association in response to their request for grant consideration for water run-off projects.

Bill seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● Maury made a motion to approve the certification of the "cord wood" portion of the Report of Cut for S. Giffin.

Bill seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● Bill made a motion to approve an abatement request from S. Giffin as recommended following a review by Avitar.

Maury seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● Brenna made a motion to deny an abatement request from the Harris Center as recommended following a review by Avitar.

Bill seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● Brenna made a motion to approve an abatement request from R. & B. Lenox regarding a LUCT levy made in error. This was recommended by Avitar following a site visit and review of the documentation. Maury seconded.  
The motion carried 3-0.

● Edie reported that Eckman Engineering has now completed the field work portion for the bridge repair at West Shore Road.

● Richard Pratt came before the Board and reported that he remains unable to take time away from his business for daytime patrols or routine “on-duty” shifts in town and plans to go forward with retirement from police service in Nelson and also plans to resign his other Town positions. (Fire Warden, Health Officer)

● At 3:35 PM the Board moved to the Town Hall to complete the final meeting of the EOP update.
