

# Joint Loss Management Committee

February 25, 2014

The first topic of discussion concerned the storage and use of gasoline in its present location at the Town Barn/Safety Building property.

All department heads and committee members agreed to recommend to the Select Board that large volume storage and dispensing of gasoline be stopped.

Container storage for gasoline was then discussed for small equipment use.

Mike Tarr suggested a "long life" gas with a shelf life of approximately 3 years be considered.

Bud French suggested a gasoline caddy system.

Ron O'Keefe agreed to check on the amounts that can be stored.

David Upton made a motion to recommend that the Select Board adopt off site gasoline purchase.

Jason Walter seconded the motion.

The motion was unanimously approved.

There was a brief discussion regarding Health Physicals for all Firefighters. (NFPA Physical)

All agreed that there are pros and cons to such a program and the cost would be high.

Jason Walter suggested that the Fire Department could possibly consider this in the future.

Diesel Fuel storage was then discussed and all quickly agreed it is best to leave the diesel where it is currently stored and dispensed.

Ron O'Keefe offered to present a training session at the next JLMC meeting on May 27, 2014. All agreed.

David made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 29, 2013 meeting.

Jason seconded the motion.

The motion was unanimously approved.

The Fire department and the Road agent will research gas caddies for limited gasoline storage at the highway Barn.

With nothing further David made a motion to adjourn.

Jason seconded.

The motion then carried by unanimous vote.
