

**Town of Nelson  
Selectmen's Meeting  
Election Recount**

March 22, 2017

At 10:00 AM David Upton opened the March 22, 2017 meeting of the Nelson Select Board for the purpose of participating in an official recount of the position of Selectman on this year's ballot. The recount had been requested by Robert Lenox, a write in for the position of Selectman (3 yr. term) Maury Collins was running for re-election and had signed up to run so his name did appear on the ballot. Participants included the Town Moderator, the Town Clerk, a Supervisor of the checklist, the Select Board Chair, David Upton and Selectman, Gary Robinson .

● Lew Derby, Town Moderator explained the process to all participants and attendees. The Moderator called out each vote, The Town Clerk and the Supervisor of the checklist kept separate tally sheets, all participants were required to view the ballots.

● The final count confirmed that Maury Collins did win the election.  
Maury Collins: 63 votes                      Robert Lenox: 60 votes  
Town Clerk, Julia Lennon immediately swore in Maury Collins for a 3 year term as Selectmen. His term will expire in March of 2020.

● With nothing further, David made a motion to adjourn.
