- 2. Skillings & Sons, Inc. Bid \$15,497 plus \$11.00 LF beyond 320 in depth and \$1,800.00 hydrofracking. No Optional bid and no references provided as requested.
- 3. Green Mountain Bid \$10,364.23 plus \$10.00 LF beyond 320 in depth and \$2,800.00 hydrofracking. No Optional bid and no references provided as requested.

Mr. Cushing was advised that the Board would review the bids in detail before making a final decision.
