At 3:00 PM Brenna Kucinski opened the May 4, 2022 meeting of the Nelson Select Board.

● Maury made a motion to approve the minutes for April 27, 2022 as recorded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● Maury made a motion to approve the manifest for May 4, 2022 as presented.

The motion carried 3-0.

● Eric Aldrich came before the Board to urge the Select Board to consider a Warrant Article in 2023 (Not by petition) for the closure of the section of Nubanusit Road that is a class VI roadway. He presented concern over the use of the road by motorized vehicles that are causing damage. He suggests that Nelson, and a small section in Harrisville, change this area to a Class A Trail. He suggested using trail cameras to catch those violating the road or trail and submitting the evidence to the Police department for further action. The Selectmen agreed to study the matter further and take it under advisement.

● Al made a motion to accept, with the Town's gratitude, two donations made in Memory of Bill Raynor for use by the Nelson Cemetery.

Brenna seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● Maury made a motion to approve an Intent to Cut submitted by W. Klemperer

Brenna seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● The Board discussed options for dealing with the parking issues on Old Stoddard Road as hikers seek to use the trails in Partridge Woods. This has become a problem for property owners as the area as visitors have not always been considerate of the landowner's rights. Brenna will meet with the Police Chief and the Road Agent to visit the area in order to consider the best location for signage.

● The Board agreed to further seek to commission a "Town Cane" that would be passed to the oldest resident.

● D. Schillemat popped in briefly to inform the Board he would like to amend his previously approved Building Permit. He will bring the new information to Edie to prepare for consideration by the Board.

● With nothing further, Brenna made a motion to adjourn.
