

**Town of Nelson
Selectmen's Meeting
3:00 PM**

June 1, 2022

Executive Board Attending: Brenna Kucinski, Maury Collins, Al Guida, Edie Drinkwater, Admin. Assist.

Others attending: J. Filipi, M. Tarr

At 3:00 PM Brenna Kucinski opened the June 1, 2022 meeting of the Nelson Select Board.

- Police Chief Filipi came before the Board to update the status of the Police Department. He reviewed several items for discussion:
 - Recommends posting a Help Wanted ad for the position of additional Police Officer
 - Brenna will ask the Black Fly to post the position - Edie will check NHMS website for posting
 - Reports that the mice seem to be finally under control
 - Old firearms that have accumulated over the years will be traded in for new
 - A previous Chief will sign off on the firearms purchased by the town during his term.
 - Wayne Kassotis will continue with the department, providing administrative service and animal control assistance
 - Wayne will also provide Traffic assistance during Old Home Days
 - Chief Filipi will be away the last 2 weeks of June for education completion

- Brenna made a motion to approve the minutes for May 25, 2022 as recorded.
Al seconded.
The motion carried 3-0.

- Maury made a motion to approve the manifest for June 1, 2022 as presented.
Al seconded.
The motion carried 3-0.

- Maury made a motion to approve 3 "Doomage" letter for failure to report timber cuts for 2021.
Brenna seconded.
The motion carried 3-0.

- Maury made a motion to approve a letter to the Conservation Commission regarding the Selectmen's position on payment for trail/parking signage.
Al seconded.
The motion carried 3-0.

- Maury made a motion to approve a letter to E. & R. Schillemat Revocable Trust regarding the terms and conditions to receive a new Building Permit.
Brenna seconded.
The motion carried 3-0.

- Maury made a motion to approve a Bid from Sandri Co. LLC for tree removal at the Nelson Cemetery in the amount of \$7,000.
Brenna seconded.
The motion carried 3-0.

- Al made a motion to approve a Business License for Robyn Anderson to provide Child Care Services in her home at 96 Nubanusit Road for up to 12 children as indicated in her application.

Brenna seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

- Following a discussion, it was agreed that Maury or Mike Tarr will mow the ballfield for use by Old Home Day.

At 4:05 PM

- Brenna made a motion to move into Non-Public session in accordance with RSA 91-A:3 (a&c) Personnel and Harm to reputation.

Al seconded.

The motion carried by roll call vote 3-0. Maury – yes, Al – yes, Brenna – yes

At 4:12 PM

- Upon returning to Public session, Brenna made a motion to seal the minutes.

Al seconded.

The motion then carried by roll call vote 3-0. Maury – yes, A – yes, Brenna - yes

- A postal worker arrived with a certified letter from D. Upton. His letter indicated that he believes the stone wall designating the boundary of his land (along the road) has been buried over the years with gravel buildup during road maintenance resulting in a widening of the road and disappearance of the stone wall. He is requesting that the Selectmen meet with him to view the situation and consider action.

- Mike Tarr came before the Board to request consideration of a request to perform reclaiming of a small, very bad, section of Granite Lake Road toward Sullivan. This would be followed by a warrant article in 2023 to repave the section. The Board requested that he seek bids so it can be determined if there is enough money in this year's budget and to keep in mind the increased costs of other line items that will also need to be met.

- The Board reopened discussion of mowing the ballfield. It was agreed that Maury's equipment would do a better job for the intended use. Maury agreed to try to complete the mowing by Old Home Day within the next two weeks.

- The Board then discussed the Upton letter with M. Tarr. The Board did not get a clear picture of the problem that Upton described from his attached photos. All agreed to review the property deed, map, and file for any clues to the existence/location of the stone wall before further discussion with Upton.

● With nothing further, Al made a motion to adjourn.

The motion carried 3-0.
