Others attending:

At 1:00 PM David Upton opened the June 3, 2020 meeting of the Nelson Select Board.

● Maury made a motion to approve the minutes for May 27, 2020 as recorded.

The motion carried 3-0 by roll call vote. Maury – yes, Gary – yes, David - yes

● David made a motion to approve the Non-Public minutes (Session #1 & #2) for May 20, 2020.

● The Board opened discussion regarding a new lawn mower purchased by the Sexton following failure of the old mower. Maury explained that he discussed the problem with the Sexton and indicated that the Town would reimburse the cost as it is to be use solely by the town.
