

# Town of Nelson

## Selectmen's Meeting 1:00 PM

July 21, 2021

Executive Board Attending: Gary Robinson, Maury Collins, Brenna Kucinski, Edie Drinkwater, Admin. Assist.

Others attending:

At 1:00 PM Gary Robinson opened the July 21, 2021 meeting of the Nelson Select Board.

- Brenna immediately made a motion to appoint Gary Robinson to the position of Chair. Maury seconded. The motion quickly carried 3-0.

- Gary made a motion to approve the minutes for the July 14, 2021 Select Board meeting as recorded. Maury seconded. The motion carried 2-0. (Previous Selectman chaired that meeting – absent from this vote)

- Gary made a motion to approve the manifest for July 21, 2021 as presented. Maury seconded. The motion carried 3-0.

- Gary made a motion to approve letters to the Trustees of Trust Funds along with checks slatted for deposit into the Capital Reserve and Expendable Trust Funds as approved at the 2021 Town Meeting held on July 17, 2021. Brenna seconded. The motion carried 3-0.

- Maury made a motion to approve a Purchase Request from the Highway department for crushed stone for the paving project on Center Pond Road. Brenna seconded. The motion carried 3-0.

- A brief discussion opened regarding the Town's Purchasing Policies. It was agreed that the policies will be reviewed for consideration of amendments.

- Edie reviewed the 2021 MS-232 and pointed out the differences from the 2021 MS-636 due to the failure of two warrant articles at the Town Meeting on July 17, 2021. Brenna made a motion to approve the MS-232 for submission to NH DRA. Gary seconded. The motion carried 3-0.

- Following a brief discussion, Gary made a motion to approve David Upton to complete the Eversource bill allocation for maximizing the use of energy being produced to offset usage. Maury seconded. The motion carried 3-0.

- Discussion opened regarding new appointments for the Town Buildings Committee and the Nelson Vehicles Emissions Reduction Committee. Gary made a motion to table discussion at this time as he would like to contact members to determine their interest or suggestions. Brenna seconded. The motion carried 3-0.

- Elaine Giacomo submitted a request for the Cub Scouts to use the ballfield for a rocket launch and picnic on August 4, 2021.

Brenna made a motion to approve the request for the Cub Scouts.

Gary seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● Following a checklist review, Maury made a motion to approve a Building Permit for K. Rich for the construction of a 12' X 28' planting/propagation shed.

Brenna seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● Maury made a motion to accept the resignation of David Upton as Deputy Health Officer.

Brenna seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● Maury then nominated Gary Robinson as Deputy Health Officer.

Brenna seconded.

The motion carried 3-0. The nomination will be forwarded to the State for confirmation.

● Gary made a motion to send all notification letters in accordance with the passage of article #18 at the Nelson Town Meeting on July 17, 2021.

Brenna seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● Maury made a motion to send all notification letters in accordance with the passage of article #19 at the Nelson Town Meeting on July 17, 2021.

Brenna seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.

● Brenna reported that extensive driveway clearing is being done on property located at 32 Old Stoddard Road that appears to extend very close or within wetlands. Following further discussion, Brenna made a motion that DES be notified to inspect the property for possible violations.

Maury seconded.

The motion carried 3-0.
