● J. Filipi presented the Board with a list of calls handled from August 1, 2024 thru J 31, 2024 for their review.

● Following a review of projected revenues for 2024, Mike made a motion to approve the MS-434 for submission to DRA and to include \$200,000 to reduce taxes with further consideration of this amount expected when the tax rate is set.

● The State Shoreland Permit approval for the Dry Hydrant at Granite Lake arrived today and was signed by the Select Board Chair in preparation for posting at the work site.

● The NH State Assessing Association ballot was signed by the Select Board Chair for submission.
