At 2:00 PM Brenna and Maury opened the September 8, 2021 meeting of the Nelson Select Board.

● A letter of resignation was presented from Gary Robinson. Following a brief discussion, Maury made a motion to accept the resignation.

Brenna seconded.

The motion carried 2-0.

● With the position of Chair now open, Maury made a motion to appoint Brenna as Chair.

Brenna seconded.

The motion carried 2-0.

● The Board began discussion of an interim Board member to serve until the 2022 election. It was agreed that Bill Dunn would be asked to consider filling the vacant position.

● Brenna made a motion to approve the minutes for September 1, 2021 as recorded.

Maury seconded.

The motion carried 2-0.

● Brenna made a motion to approve the manifest for September 8, 2021 as presented.

Maury seconded.

The motion carried 2-0.

● Following a full review of house and site plans as well as consideration of all applicable zoning ordinances, Brenna made a motion to deny a Building Permit for E. Schillemat and to refer his project to the Zoning Board for consideration of a variance due to non-compliance with article 3:5. (Lack of road frontage)

Maury seconded.

The motion carried 2-0.

● Police Chief Pratt came before the Board with a request to hire two part-time police officers. Certified Police Officer Zach Letourneau accompanied him at the meeting. He introduced Officer Letourneau to the Board and followed up by presenting a plan to have two officers share available patrol time. The second officer was not available but the Board visited briefly with Officer Letourneau. Chief Pratt was advised that the Board will discuss his proposal further and let him know their decision.

● R. Pratt reported that he has two parties interested in the E-One Sentry Fire Truck but no offers have been made to purchase. He agreed to contact the parties to see if they are still interested.

The Board then agreed to have Pratt bring the old jeep brush truck to his car lot to see if there may be interest in that truck as well.

● Brenna made a motion to move forward with the process to hire just one part-time police officer at this time and to complete all necessary paperwork to consider Z. Letourneau for the position as a new part-time police officer.

Maury seconded.

The motion carried 2-0.

● With nothing further, Maury made a motion to adjourn.

Brenna seconded.

The motion carried 2-0.
