The Board of Selectmen has agreed to include a Warrant Article on the 2019 Town Warrant for vote of the Town on the purchase of an MPH Shield 12 speed monitor.

The NSR committee still needs to calculate possible additional costs, such as new battery, extra poles, and ask Selectmen to include those costs as well. If we have the device, we also will need to notify NH DOT of Nelson's hope to use monitor traffic on state roads within town limits. Intent is to use monitor on any road within town limits.

Question arose about how to include mention of application for grant in budget that will cover 50% of cost in way that shows town intent to accept grant if awarded to Nelson.

We will check with Harrisville to see if they received grant—find out how they worded application.

Kelly French called in, was able to let us know that she has emailed NH DOT about placing school zone signs now that Granite Lake Rd has been repaved—no response as yet.

Val, Mary, Chief Pratt will work on wording and information needed to complete grant application so we are ready when application time arrives.

Although committee's major objectives—flyer, raffle, and inclusion of warrant article for MPH Shield 12 in 2019 Town Warrant—have been accomplished, future meetings and communications will continue on 4th Tuesday of the month. **Next meeting: Tuesday October 23, 7pm, lower level of library.**
