Members present: Bud French, Margaret Schillemat, and Bert Wingerson; also Dennis Dellagreca, Maureen Lord attended the meeting.

1. Dennis Dellagreca discussed the numerous violations on the Congoran property on Nubanusit Lake that have occurred without required permits from the DES. Dennis presented photos of problem areas including excavating and expanding of the footprint of the primary building in the protected shoreland, discharge of sewage, and reconstruction of a seasonal dock. The owners are scheduled to meet with the selectmen tomorrow night concerning these violations. Bud has made a site visit to the property and will attend the selectmen's meeting with Margaret to represent the Commission.

Dennis also reported that his issues with the DES concerning downstream siltation on his property have been addressed and no further action is necessary.

Dennis also requested that the Commission work with the Trails Committed to insure the any requirements of the DES concerning wetlands are met with.

- 2. The forestry project on the Putzel property, which includes tree cutting to open view sheds, thin areas, and create a pasture, was again reviewed. Much of the work has been done in accordance with the filed forestry plan. Bud has made a site visit with Meade Cadot of the Harris Center.
- 3. The Roeder project on Granite Lake was reviewed. The DES has issued a permit to install a poured concrete foundation under the non-conforming structure and to add a shed and walkway. It was noted that the size of the shed may require a review by the ZBA.
- 4. A successful Roadside Clean Up was held on Saturday, Aug. 11. There were 27 residents and friends who volunteered to pick up trash along the roads. Anne McBride, Kathy Schillemat, and Bert Wingerson manned the registration table.
