- 1. The updated town conservation easement maps prepared by Anne McBride were delivered and reviewed. Copies will be given to various town boards and will be available for purchase by residents who request one.
- 2. Roadside Cleanup. The annual roadside cleanup sponsored by New Hampshire the Beautiful does not have funding to supply the daffodils this year. The NCC voted to buy them to continue this tradition. As usual, it was decided to hold the event on the Saturday before Old Home Week, this year being August 6th.
- 3. Lake Host Program. A request was made by the Granite Lake Assoc. to fund the monitoring program at the lake again this year in the amount of \$1500. It was vote to continue our support for this season.
- 4. Vernal Pool Program. Kathy reported that she has sent out publicity for the program noting that lack of rain (one vernal pool is dry) may alter some of her plans as to location of the walk.
- 5. NH Assoc. of CC's. Information was sent by email from the NHACC concerning proposed legislation that would add some restrictions for the gathering of field research data from private properties. It was noted that we have been following those procedures in the past.
- 6. The Monadnock Conservancy is holding a series of four conservation training sessions in May. The NCC has offered to fund members of the Zoning and Planning Boards and the Selectmen to attend.
