

Nelson Select Board Resolution

Relative to Cancellation of the 2020

Business Portion of the Nelson Town Meeting

Whereas:

1. The COVID-19 virus is highly contagious.
2. The disease caused by the virus is potentially lethal, especially for the elderly and for those with chronic medical conditions.
3. Once contracted, there is no established safe and effective treatment for the disease.
4. There presently exists no safe and effective vaccine for the prevention of the disease.
5. There presently exists no testing protocol that can determine, in real time, if an individual is a carrier of the disease.

The turnaround time **is** a minimum of 72 hours from **the** time **the** NH PHL receives your specimen. That means if you got **tested** on Monday, your specimen may not arrive at **the** NH PHL until Tuesday. You **results** **would** not be available until Friday (commercial laboratories **are** reporting a similar turnaround time).




