Mike made a motion to approve an invoice for 3 pairs of boots for new members of the Fire Department. Don seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

Mike made a motion to approve an invoice regarding the moving of a radio bay station for the Fire Department. Brenna seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

The board then took a trip down to the existing Nelson Welcome Sign. There had been some disagreement regarding the size of the sign.
