

SELECTMEN MEETING

June 1, 2011

Present: Michael Blaudschun, Chair; Margaret Schillemat& Warren Hammack, Selectmen.

Others Attending: Chris Chesney, Bldg permit and DES approval; Terry Mednick, Building Permit; Karen Tolman& Sandy MacKenzie, Resource Sharing Committee; and Richard Pratt, Jr. Police Chief.

- 1) Meeting opened at 6:40pm by Michael Blaudschun, Chair, Seconded by Margaret. Meeting opened.
- 2) All paperwork was looked at read and signed as necessary.
- 3) Selectmen's Meeting adjourned for an executive session at 7:10pm by Mike seconded by Margaret.
- 4) Executive Session opened at 7:12pm. And closed at 7:25pm.
- 5) Mike reopened the Selectmen meeting at 7:30pm seconded by warren. Motion carried.
- 6) Mr. Chris Chesney came to speak to the selectmen about his building project and the demolition of the cottage. He is going to build on the same spot as the cottage now sits and he has sent the required paperwork to DES. The town has a copy of the paperwork. He was given a demolition permit to fill out and return to the office before any demolition can begin. He had two other gentlemen with him that have worked with the DES and understood what needed to be done, so things should go along as needed.
- 7) Terry Mednick came to speak with the selectmen about his building permit to build 24'x40' garage. The selectmen signed his permit and Terry was given his orange copy for display.
- 8) The selectmen asked that Owen please remove the wire off of the upstairs window in the OBS and make sure it can be opened for egress. He also needs to make a clear path to the window so people can get to it easily.
- 9) Joan will speak to Rob Germeroth about the wood in the back of the OBS. If he wants it then they will not have Mike Tarr remove it.

10) Tim Rohr will do a analysis for us to see if it would be cheaper to have our two full time employees go with the school health insurance program. As soon as the selectmen will inform the townspeople.

11) Karen Tolman and Sandy MacKenzie came to talk of the Resource Sharing committee. The first subject of interest was sharing the Harrisville waste station. It was decided that Harrisville could do a survey of the Town of Nelson to see if there was enough interest in using the Harrisville station.

The Capital Improvement Plan is done by the Planning Board. Dave Voymas, Chair of the P/B said that the Capital Improvement Plan is the next thing on the P/B agenda.

Resident Power Lighting for your home as individuals is being offered for the first time to towns. Right now the Resource Sharing Committee is working with Harrisville but could possibly do other towns such as Dublin, Marlborough, Peterborough and others. This could add up to a 5% to 20% savings. There will be different choices you can make with different plans etc.

The selectmen will be joining the Committee for some meetings in the future. They asked if they could ask Department Heads to join or be invited to some of the meetings and the selectmen said to invite or ask the Department Heads if they wished. They were also told to contact the selectmen if the committee had something decisive or questions on or for their agenda, they can contact the Selectmen for information.


12) The selectmen's meeting adjourned at 9:45pm by Mike seconded by Margaret. Motion carried.
