

SELECTMEN MEETING
MARCH 31, 2010

Present: Michael Blaudschun, Chair; Margaret Schillemat & Warren Hammack, Selectmen.

Others Attending: Gordon Peery, Dawn Amer, Treasurer; Elaine Giacomo, Betsey Church, Richard Pratt Jr., Police Chief; and Rick Lothrop, Fire Chief.

1) Mike Blaudschun opened the selectmen's meeting at 7:05pm. Seconded by Margaret Schillemat. Motioned carried unanimously. All paperwork was signed and read for this week.

2) Gordon Peery came to discuss the Town Web-site with the selectmen. The selectmen's weekly minutes have not been put on our web site yet as the selectmen asked. Gordon wanted to wait until maybe a trustee from the library could work with him and have a better flow between the library and the selectmen's office. E-mails between the selectmen's office and the library will be running better within the next week.

3) Dawn Amer, Treasurer came to talk with the selectmen about some duties to need to be looked into such as:

1-Dawn has been working with Tom Buttrick our former treasurer and has received 2 bank statements out of six.

2) Computer Solutions will be getting a computer for Dawn to use in the office. All of the treasurer's work will be handled in house from now on.

3) The town is looking at getting TD Bank to do the town cards.

4) The town will get a multi-user license for Quick Books so that all three users can be in the system at the same time for training and input.


Dawn will be keeping the selectmen up to date on any changes that occur.

4) Elaine Giacomo and Betsey Church came to ask the selectmen if the town bought the paint they would paint the library bathrooms and vestibule. They will purchase new seats for the bathrooms also.

- 5) The selectmen will be making an appointment with the town attorney, Gary Kinyon to discuss an easement on the Geddes property. The appointment will be for April 15th at 4:30pm if possible.
- 6) Contact Carol Raynsford for information on her town hall rental.
- 7) There is a problem between two town residences on a private road. The Police Chief is looking into the situation.
- 8) Call the Auditor from the warrant article to check on availability for year 2010 audit.
- 9) The DRA will be sending our Equalization rates soon and if they are no lower than 98 % to 99% the DRA may let the town do a statistical revaluation. The selectmen will be looking into this for the town 2010 audit next year.
- 10) Mike Blaudschun adjourned the selectmen's meeting at 10:05pm. Seconded by Margaret Schillemat. Motion passed unanimously.
