

SELECTMEN MEETING
May 12, 2010

Present: Michael Blaudschun, Chair; Margaret Schillemat & Warren Hammack, Selectmen.

Others Attending: Vangie McCormick, Dave Marazoff, Sarah Sheppard, Mary Alice Fox, Rick Lothrop, Fire Chief; Richard Pratt, Police Chief.

1) All correspondence was read and signed, including last weeks' minutes for the selectmen's meeting.

2) Vangie McCormick came to ask the selectmen if there would be a problem with the Munsonville Ladies Club having their Christmas Bazaar at the school this year. Also, with the parking lot at the school would the club need to pay for police presence for vehicle parking. The selectmen did not feel that the cost of police presence would be necessary but they would speak with Police Chief Pratt and let Vangie know the answer to that. The ladies club meets every 3rd Thursday of the month at 7:00 o'clock pm. This years' Christmas Bazaar will be held on December 11, 2010 at 9:00 o'clock in the morning. This is the second Saturday of the month this year.


3) Dave Marazoff, Cross Country Appraisal Group, came to speak of abatements, current use land and other issues with the revaluation and other properties that need assessment changes.

- Abatements: There were properties up for abatements. Three properties were granted abatements and one was denied.
- Current Use properties need to follow the current use criteria and as well as any exemption property. There appears to be some confusion on property that have both current use and exemption status.
- It does not appear that the town will be able to do a statistical revaluation this coming year as this is the year the state said we need to do a full revaluation.
- Some properties will have a new assessment because of inventories changes done before April 1, 2010.


