

SELECTMEN MEETING

SEPTEMBER 15, 2010

Present: Michael Blaudschun, Chair; Warren Hammack, Selectman. Absent: Margaret Schillemat, Selectman.

Others Attending: Jack Bradshaw

- 1) All paperwork was read and signed, including the minutes from the last selectmen meeting.
- 2) Jack Bradshaw came before the selectmen to discuss the ongoing progress of the Town Hall Renovation Committee. He had some plans for the three town buildings, the Town Hall, the Old Brick Schoolhouse and the Library. The original \$10,000 that was set for this project is as follows:
 - 1) \$5000 for Weller & Michal Architects Inc.
 - 2) \$1000 for SVE, Stephen Tarbox
 - 3) \$1000 for Mechanical/Electrical
 - 4) \$2000 for DiBernardo Associates, LLC-Surveying
 - 5) \$1000 is the balance on the \$10,000 as of this date.

A public meeting will be held Tuesday September 28, 2010 at the Town Hall at 5:30pm with the Selectmen, the Town Hall Renovation Committee and Mr. Tom Weller, the Architect. This will be an informative meeting for anyone who wishes to attend.

- 3) Jeffrey Schillemat/Boy Scout came to update the selectmen on his Eagle Scout project. He is planning to put a Bulletin Board at Center Pond road boat ramp. The board would be for DES postings, Warning signs, Don't feed the waterfowl etc. The sign would be positioned on the left side of the road, either on Coughlin's or Laughlin's land. The board will be 4' x 8' and painted white. The district troop committee approves this project. One question was who would maintain the sign.
